- 2. Submit an application to the legal entity of public law National Centre for Education Quality Enhancement of Georgia

N.B. The second step is taken only if the applicant is accepted through the entrance exams at the TSC

The TSC selects degree students only once a year, in June.

THE APPLICATION PERIOD for degree students is open between May 1 and June 10 (the application period ends at 5 p.m. Georgian time).

## EXCHANGE STUDIES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

- TSC joined Erasmus + ICM program in 2015;
- TSC has an Erasmus PIC Number: 932283976
- Under the Erasmus+ exchange scheme the TSC signed inter-institutional agreements with its Erasmus partner HEIs across the Europe
- These agreements allow TSC as well as International students to study under Erasmus exchange program without paying an extra fee

#### Getting Accommodation in Georgia

TSC has no studnet dormitory. International students applying to study at the TSC, are completely responsible for finding the accommodation. Please get us aware of how you would like to live in Georgia, make an indication in your application form, so we could give the directions needed.

Prices for accommodation vary in Tbilisi:

- cheap accommodation Monthly price starts from 100USD home-stay in a hospitable Georgian Family
- Average price for the apartment of 40-60m<sup>2</sup> starts from 300USD per month, the apartment can be shared by several students
- Also there are some hotels and the daily price starts from 40USD
- Double apartment, price 500USD per month, may be shared by two (2) students
- Triple room apartment, price 600USD per month, may be shared by 3-5 students
