

IN EMERGENCY SITUATION

CALL - 112 - in emergency situations.

The 112 Operator analyses all incoming calls and transfers them to the relevant services - Police, Fire/Rescue Service or Ambulance.

COMMUNICATION

The country code for Georgia is +995, followed by a two- or three-digit area code (32 for Tbilisi) and a six- to seven-digit phone number.

CELL PHONES: You can purchase SIM cards from one of the mobile providers in Georgia: Magti, Geocell (Silknet), Beeline

OPENING A BANK ACCOUNT

To open an account, you will need to visit a branch in person – it's not possible to open an account from outside the country. The biggest banks in Georgia are TBC Bank and Bank of Georgia (BOG).

- 4. Citizens and stateless persons permanently residing in the countries listed through the link may enter and stay in Georgia without a visa. Please, note that citizens of Member States of the European Union may enter Georgia with a travel document, as well as with an identity card issued by a Member State of the European Union. The identity card shall contain the name, surname, date of birth and a photo of the person. The maximum period of stay without a visa is 1 full year.
